

Gordon King has long been regarded as one of this country's most popular contemporary figurative artists. His first book "A Romance with

Art", featuring a wide range of his oils and watercolours, was published with a forward by HRH The Princess Royal.

Gordon's paintings and limited edition prints are collected worldwide. He has held many one man exhibitions and exhibited many times at The Royal Academy Summer Exhibition and the Royal Institute of Painters in Watercolour. The prestigious award of Published Artist of the Year coincided with the publication of his second book "Drawn to Life".

His lifelong passion for equestrian subjects includes scenes from polo and hunting. A particular favourite is Royal Ascot, where his figurative skills capture the excitement and glamour of the racing calendar.

Gordon has always been actively involved in charitable work; recent projects include a collaboration with Darcy Bussell, the prima ballerina of the Royal Ballet Company, on behalf of the Alzheimer's Society and another with legendary rock band *Status Quo* for The Prince's Trust.

Gordon's passion for painting is as strong as ever, working from his Buckinghamshire studio, rising early to catch the morning light.

Gordon is pleased to have been commissioned to paint **The British Military Horse Trilogy**, combining elements of his own military background with his love of horses. The Trilogy features mounted dutymen of the Household Cavalry Musical Ride (composed of men and horses of The Life Guards and The Blues and Royals), and gun teams from The Musical Drive of The King's Troop, Royal Horse Artillery. These outstanding military display teams are here depicted performing at the last ever Royal Tournament in 1999. Now specially commissioned for 2010, the Trilogy's objective from conception has been to raise awareness and funds for those soldiers returning from all theatres of war who have sustained life changing injuries.

The Household Cavalry Operational Casualties Fund (HCOCF) aims to help provide financial support to injured soldiers and their families, including those who have lost their lives on active service.
